



Champion of Champions

4 year old requirements:

- lengthen steps in trot and canter
- medium walk letting the horse stretch on a long rein
- demonstrate working trot rising and sitting
- serpentine of 2 loops
- stretch on a long rein on a 20 m. circle

The 4 year old should show clear balance, working through the back, loose, carrying, active hind legs, and light footed.

A 4 year old should show rideability, and be ridden in a way he can cope with the demands of the test.



5 year old requirements:

- medium walk
- turn on the haunches
- collected, working and medium canter
- collected, working and medium trot
- counter canter left or right rein
- simple change of leg on both reins

The 5 year old should show elastic, expressive natural paces ,with an uphill tendency, Good use of the hind leg stepping under the body. Should appear light on its feet and show a willingness to collect , and should be ridden in a way he can cope with the demands of the test.



6 year old requirements:

- 3 natural paces. absolutely regular
- clear difference within the paces from extension to collection with trot and canter
- elastic paces with clearly defined transitions. showing uphill tendency, and freedom of the shoulders,
- ability to collect
 - shoulder in left and right
 - half pass left and right in trot
 - half pirouette left and right
 - flying change left and right
 - The 6 year old should now show not only the willingness to collect but the ability to collect
 - Transitions between the paces should be tension free
 - Should be ridden in a way the horse demonstrates that they can cope with the demands of the test.



6 year old pony requirements:

- > 3 clear and balanced paces
- > Half circle in canter giving and re taking the rein for a few strides.
- > simple change left and right
- > half pirouette in walk left or right
- . shoulder in left and right
- > rein back $\frac{3}{4}$ steps.
- > should be ridden in a way that they can cope with the demands of the test.
